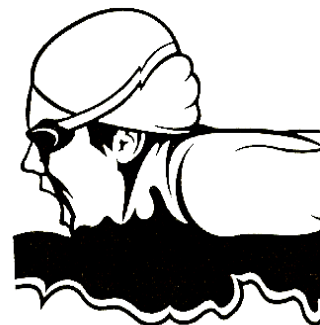

**QUALIFYING FOR THE STATE MEET**

The top two swimmers in each individual event at the region meet will automatically qualify for the state meet. The remaining qualifiers will be based on the best verifiable times from qualifying or region meets to a total of 24 swimmers per individual event. The top relay in each relay event at region meet will automatically qualify for the state meet. The remaining qualifiers will be based on the best verifiable times from the top 50 list or the region meet to a total of 16 relays in 3A, 4A and 5A.

**STATE ENTRIES AND COACHES' INFORMATION**

State entries must be submitted electronically on the **HY-TEK program by 3:00 pm Friday, January 29.** The HY-TEK file, which includes entries for individual and relay events and the names of any non-individually qualified relay alternates (limit of four per school), must be emailed to the 4A State Meet Director, **Dan Miller at [mild754@gmail.com](mailto:mild754@gmail.com)** by the deadline above. One alternate is allowed on individual events. There will not be any alternate relay teams (i.e., 17, 18).

All coaches and team managers (limited to a combination of 3) must be submitted with your electronic entry. Please let the state meet director know if you have any parents or swimmers willing to work the entire meet as timers. The unofficial meet will be emailed back to each coach by Saturday and the official one will be emailed on Monday. If there is a need, contact Dan Miller (801-360-7098) by Sunday night with any concerns.

Swimmers shall adhere to the new **NFHS Swimsuit Rule 3-3-2** posted on the UHSAA website. All athletes who qualify through the region meet must participate in the state meet as per the NFHS Book. If a swimmer will not be present for the state meet, he or she must be scratched at the conclusion of the region meet and **before the results are turned in** at the seeding meeting. Last minute **emergency scratches will be accepted at the coaches meeting on Friday.**

**DECK PASSES REQUIRED**

**Admittance to the deck area requires a deck pass and picture I.D. for EVERYONE!** Ushers will check the pass and photo I.D. (i.e. driver's license, activity card) for everyone entering the deck area. **Three (3) total deck passes will be given per school for coaches and managers.** Participant deck passes will be generated from the state qualifying list, which means schools do not submit the old deck admittance forms. **Passes will be issued only to those who qualify for State.** Passes may be picked up from the UHSAA after 1:00 pm the Wednesday preceding the meet or at the site on Friday. Participants must have passes with them at all times other than when swimming. Random checks may be made because of deck space and to ensure that we meet fire codes.

## **BUS DROP-OFF & TEAM PICK-UP**

**BUSES UNLOAD at the Richards P.E. Building NORTHWEST DOORS and then PARK IN LOT WEST OF LAVELL EDWARDS FOOTBALL STADIUM.** Coaches should call on their cell phones for pickup and be outside waiting when bus arrives. DRIVERS MUST NOT PARK OR WAIT CURBSIDE TO PICKUP TEAMS!

## **SUPERVISION**

Coaches, please be judicious in ensuring that your swimmers do not abuse our privileges while on the university campus. Do not allow your swimmers to wander the building or grounds unsupervised.

## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

**BALLOONS ARE NOT ALLOWED** in any part of the BYU facility. No glass containers will be allowed on deck. Only bottled liquids in plastic containers will be allowed on deck.

Participants must bring their own towels. Dressing room attendants will patrol the locker areas to help us take good care of the facilities.

Based on OSHA blood born pathogen regulations, **there will be no head or body shaving allowed in dressing and shower areas.** All shaving must be done prior to arrival at the meet site.

There are no diving starts allowed in the warm down pool, this pool is for feet first entry only.

## **SCORING & AWARDS**

Scoring will be for the first 16 places in swimming. Swimming medals will be given to the **first six place winners** in the **individual events**. Medals will be given to the **first three relay teams**.

Team trophies will be awarded to the first and second place winners. No hats or head coverings may be worn during awards ceremonies. Order of swimming events listed below:

## **LIMITED PARKING & SEATING**

BYU is in session on Friday. Please adhere to parking restrictions. Cars and buses will be ticketed or impounded if parked illegally. Public parking will be free in the lot west of the practice football field which is west of the Richards PE Building.

**Spectators, parents and fans should arrive early because seating is extremely limited.**

Seating is on a first come, first serve basis. Patrons are not allowed to save seats. Once the balcony is full, the Utah Fire Code prevents us from seating any additional spectators. Because of the possibility of a sell-out, arrangements may be made for a LIVE VIDEO FEED for patrons to view free of charge in Room 267. When space becomes available, BYU staff will go to Room 267 and call for the next ticket holders to fill the seats vacated by patrons.

## **ADMISSION PRICES**

**Prices for admission are \$5.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students per session.** No one will be admitted without a ticket. Tickets will be sold prior to each session at the meet site. There will be no advance sales and no reserved seats sold. The facility will be cleared after each session. A separate ticket must be purchased for each classification session.
